We will have our Christmas dinner on Tuesday 17th December and we will be inviting the children to wear Christmas jumpers with their regular uniform on this day.

Children can wear their own Christmasy clothes on Thursday 19th December ready for Hockham's Got Talent and the Christmas Fayre that is being organised by our Friend's committee after school on that day. They are asking children to come to school in their own clothes on Friday 22nd

November in exchange for a donation of a bottle (containing things such as: eg: body wash, drinks, cooking items etc) and on Friday 6th December in exchange for a sweet or chocolate treat. Please drop your donations off in the playground on your way into school. Thank you.

Finally, we will finish the Autumn term with a Whole School Christmas Celebration in Holy Trinity Church, where all classes will sing some songs and share some poems. This will be at 2.15pm and children can be collected directly from the Church if parents or carers can attend.
